CM unveils tourism projects, flags off diaspora youth tour

Chief minister M K Stalin on Friday inaugurated tourism and museum development projects worth 43crore, flagged off a cultural immersion tour for Tamil diaspora youth, and laid the foundation for 13 new co-working-cum-study centres across the city. The tourism work, totalling 18crore, aims to upgrade key destinations such as Gundaru dam in Tenkasi, Yelagiri in Tirupattur, Poondi reservoir in Tiruvallur, Muthukuda beach in Pudukkottai, and Hotel Tamil Nadu campus in Madurai with visitor centres, dining halls, walkways, and other amenities to boost employment and attract tourists. Stalin also opened a 6.8crore administrative block at the Egmore Govt Museum, designed in sync with its heritage architecture. Under Chennai Metropolitan Development Authority (CMDA), four completed projects costing 18.4crore were inaugurated, including a redeveloped park in Perumbakkam and beautified

flyover spaces at Villivakkam, Padi, and Vadapalani. He laid the foundation stone for 26 new CMDA projects worth 91.4crore, including 13 CM study centres (co-working hubs) for civil services aspirants, modern bus shelters, school upgrades, a crafts plaza at Koyambedu, and a heritage promenade from Marina Lighthouse to Island Grounds. At another event, Stalin flagged off the fourth batch of the "Vaergalai Thedi" (In Search of Roots) scheme, sending 99 Tamil diaspora youth from 14 countries, including Fiji, Reunion, South Africa, and Canada, on a 15-day cultural tour of TN. Launched in 2023, the initiative reconnects overseas Tamils aged 18-30 with their heritage through visits to historical sites, interactions with scholars, and exposure to traditional arts and architecture. Participants are expected to serve as cultural ambassadors in their home countries.

Restoring the Captain Cotton Canal A Student-Led Call for Environmental and Civic Renewal

The historic Captain Cotton Canal in Perambur is witnessing renewed attention thanks to the efforts of students, civic activists, and the Greater Chennai Corporation. Once a functional waterway used for inland transport and agriculture, the canal has over the years become choked by sewage, plastic waste, and unchecked encroachments. In response, students from Chevalier T. Thomas Elizabeth College for Women (CTTE) have taken up the cause of environmental restoration. On July 25, 2025, the Departments of Physics, Chemistry, and

Mathematics organised a student-led awareness rally and human chain formation from St. Mary's Road to the canal. Displaying placards and eco-messages, the students urged the public to avoid littering in waterways and demanded stronger civic enforcement. Media reports have also amplified the urgency. The Hindu highlighted the risks in "Micro-canals prove a major hassle for residents" and "Canals in north Chennai choked by illegal sewage, spread of water hyacinth". Most notably, the GCC has sanctioned ₹6.93 crore for the desilting of Captain Cotton Canal, as

confirmed in a July article from The Hindu. Additionally, The Times of India reported GCC's plan to raise canal walls to reduce flooding and waste dumping. In Ezhil Nagar, North Chennai, residents are similarly demanding action to clean polluted canals, according to a Times of India report. These civic movements, combined with student involvement, are building momentum toward a cleaner, safer Chennai. With sustained action, the Captain Cotton Canal could be transformed from a neglected stretch into a symbol of sustainable urban living.

IIT Madras helps Isro, Nasa fine-tune Nisar's coastal region applications

An IIT-Madras professor has contributed to shaping how Nisar, the Indo-US satellite launched on Wednesday, will observe coastal regions. Prof Manikandan Mathur of the Geophysical Flows Lab, Centre of Excellence, Department of Aerospace Engineering, IIT-Madras, helped Isro and Nasa fine-tune the satellite's operational settings by advising on when, how often, and which coastal regions should be imaged. He highlighted the need for high-resolution observations of the north Indian Ocean to improve understanding of coastal processes and their role in weather modelling and pollutant transport. Prof Mathur and his team plan to use Nisar data to study how river water mixes with the ocean in the Bay of Bengal, internal gravity waves in the coastal Indian Ocean, and how these processes influence regional weather and high-impact events like intense rainfall and flooding in the Indian subcontinent. Unlike earlier Earth observation satellites, which have either been poor in imaging coastal regions or perform poorly in cloudy weather, Nisar will provide images at resolutions of a few tens of metres and revisit the same location every 12 days. "Nisar will overcome both these drawbacks, in addition to its imaging of very fine scale features on the Earth's surface that we have never seen before," he said. "This is a unique collaboration between Isro and Nasa, combining the best of the capabilities of two different frequency bands," he added. Prof Mathur added that the open access to Nisar data would be game-changing for the Indian scientific community, especially young researchers. "The general awareness amongst the Indian scientific community about what is possible using satellite imaging is going to increase significantly," he said. It would also open up a very exciting, societally relevant area of application for the machine learning and data science community, he added.

High speed charging infrastructure for commercial vehicles soon on highways in TN Minister T R B Rajaa

State industries minister T R B Rajaa on Thursday said high speed charging infrastructure for commercial vehicles will be established in key locations on the highways soon. The departments of energy and transport with inputs from the industries department are collaborating for creating the facility. The infrastructure is expected to facilitate full charging in 30 minutes and 70% charging in 15 minutes. Speaking to reporters on the sidelines of Passenger Vehicle Expo 2.0 here, he said, this is essential to enhance EV penetration in the bus segment. "Departments of energy and transport have created a proper setup for the purpose. It is for intercity and long distance vehicles. The first infrastructure will be set up in Ulundurpet," he said. The minister emphasised the need for high speed charging infrastructure for commercial vehicles akin two-wheelers and cars. He further said, the state is conducting a mini investor conclave titled 'TN Rising' at Tuticorin next week in which some MoUs on investments are likely to be signed on the occasion. "This conclave will be taken to other industrial hubs in the state," he added. Earlier, in his address, Rajaa said, Guidance Tamil Nadu is looking at the possibility of setting up an automobile centre of excellence to work in the direction of self-reliant Tamil Nadu.

Renault gets keys to Nissan's TN plant

Four months after Renault Group announced its intent to buy out Nissan's 51% stake in joint India plant RNAIPL (Renault Nissan Automotive India Private Ltd), the French auto major has completed the acquisition and become sole owner of the Oragadam/Chennai facility. "India is a key market for Renault Group and also plays a vital role in our global R&D footprint. With full ownership of our plant in Chennai, we now have all the means to accelerate in India," said François Provost, CEO of Renault Group. The acquisition is part of Renault Group "accelerating its development in India" said the company in a statement. Renault Group has just named Stephane Deblaise as its CEO for India effective Sept 1, 2025 to lead the next phase of the French auto major's India strategy. Since its launch in 2010, the Chennai plant has produced more than 2.8 million vehicles — including 1.2 million exported to more than 100 countries — as well as 4.6 million engines and gearboxes. Supported by nearly 300 local suppliers, the plant has an annual production capacity of more than 400,000 vehicles; it is currently using nearly 50% capacity. Going forward, the plant will continue to manufacture Nissan cars as well as have some "kind of contract manufacturing arrangement," the company said. Renault expects the capacity utilization at the plant to improve as new models roll out of Oragadam for both Renault and Nissan. Currently dedicated to the CMF-A and CMF-A+ platforms, the Oragadam plant is preparing to host the group's new multi-energy modular platform, which will "support the Renault brand's future models," said the statement. The group is bullish on the local market's importance in its global strategy. "Renault Group looks to India as a key driver of international expansion," said the statement. This is part of a broader momentum, highlighted by the opening of Renault Group's largest design centre outside France, announced in April, and the launch of the new Triber — the first model in a product offensive that will include four new vehicles. Renault will both strengthen its sales in the Indian market and expand its exports. This is part of Renault brand's International Game Plan 2027.

Southern Railway to run Onam special trains between Chennai and Kollam via Coimbatore

Southern Railway has announced special trains between Chennai Central and Kollam to cater to the extra rush of passengers during the Onam festival. In a press release, the Salem railway division said train no. 06119 Chennai Central - Kollam special train will leave Chennai Central at 3.10pm on Aug 17 and Sept 3 and 10 to reach Kollam at 6.40am the next day. Train no. 06120 Kollam - Chennai Central special train will leave Kollam at 10.40am on Aug 28 and Sept 4 and 11 to reach Chennai Central at 3.30am the next day. The trains will stop at Tiruvallur, Arakkonam, Katpadi, Jolarpet, Salem, Erode, Tirupur, Podanur, Palakkad, Thrissur, Aluva, Ernakulam Town, Kottayam, Changanassery, Tiruvalla, Chengannur, Mavelikara, Kayamkulam, Karunagappalli and Sasthamkotta.

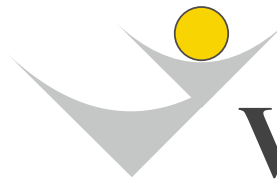
